GOODBRIDGES

- ◆ Goodbridges will serve women offenders re-entering the Manchester, Nashua and Concord communities.
- ◆ Goodbridges will serve women with risk factors indicating the likelihood of reoffending upon release.
- ◆ Goodbridges will assist women offenders in the areas of recovery coaching, job readiness and placement and community resource connections.

GOODGUIDES

- ◆ Goodwill has partnered Child and Family Services (CFS) to provide mentoring and wrap-around services to support the reintegration of juvenile offenders ages 13-17, who are returning to the community following commitment to the Sununu Youth Services Center (SYSC).
- ◆ GoodGuides® will help youth prepare for school completion, develop work skills, identify career paths and transition to post-secondary opportunities.
- ◆ GoodGuides® will help identify services to address family life, behavior and substance abuse concerns.
- ◆ GoodGuides® programs have been established in NH, ME and VT.
